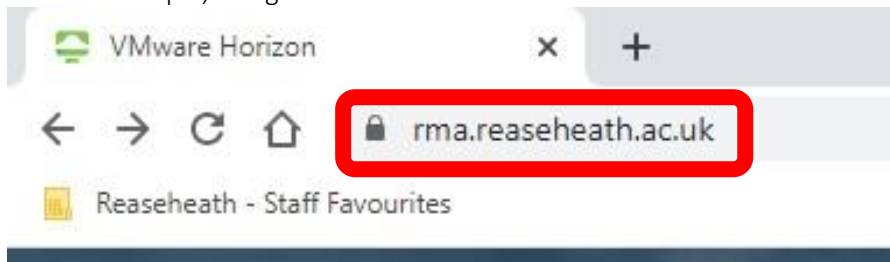

- ✓ You know the Operating System you're using, E.g. Windows 32bit or 64bit, Mac or Linux.

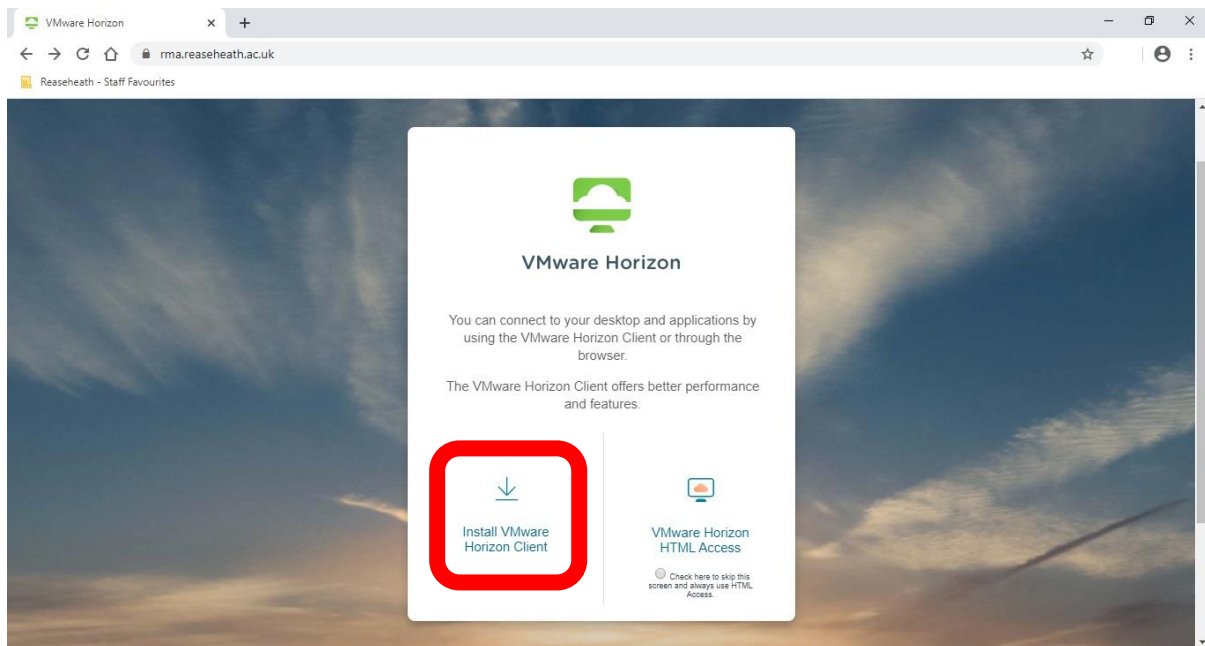
Step 1 – Web Address

Open your preferred Internet Browser and navigate to 'https://rma.reaseheath.ac.uk/'
For this example, Google Chrome will be used.



Step 2 – Downloading VMware Horizon

Select the option 'Install VMWare Horizon Client'

Once the file has downloaded click on the downward arrow located at the bottom left of the web browser then click 'Open'.



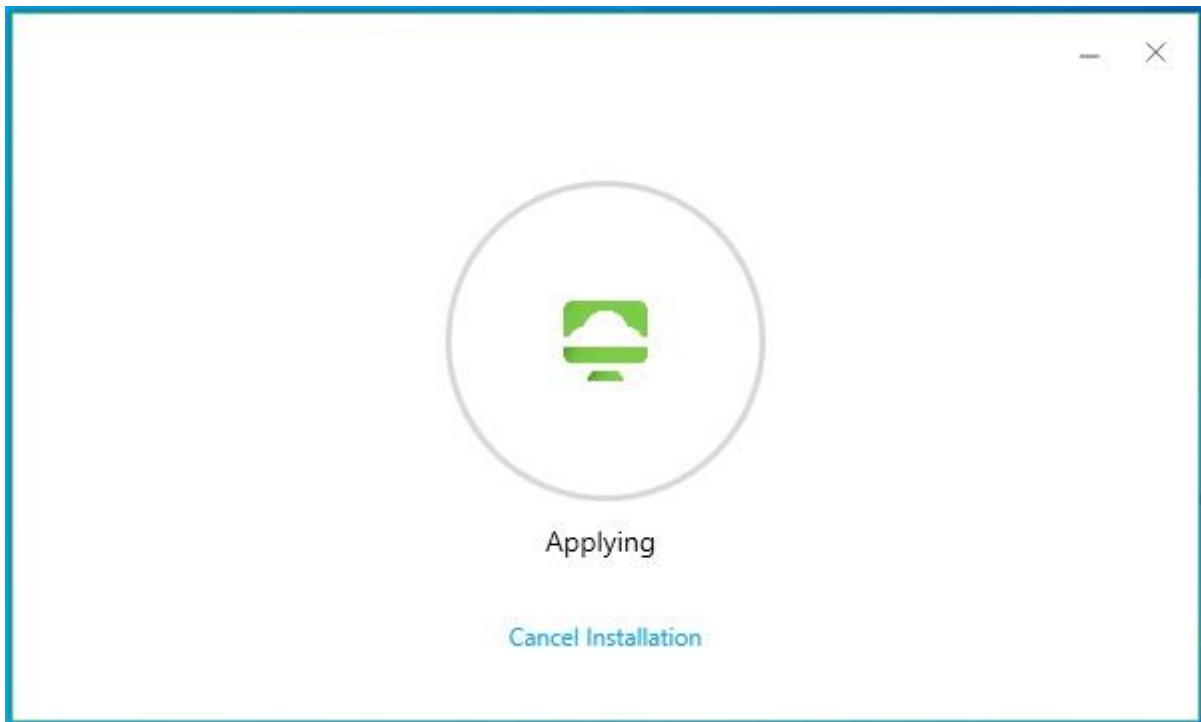
Step 3 – Installing VMware Horizon

The VMware Horizon installer will appear. Click 'Agree & Install'.



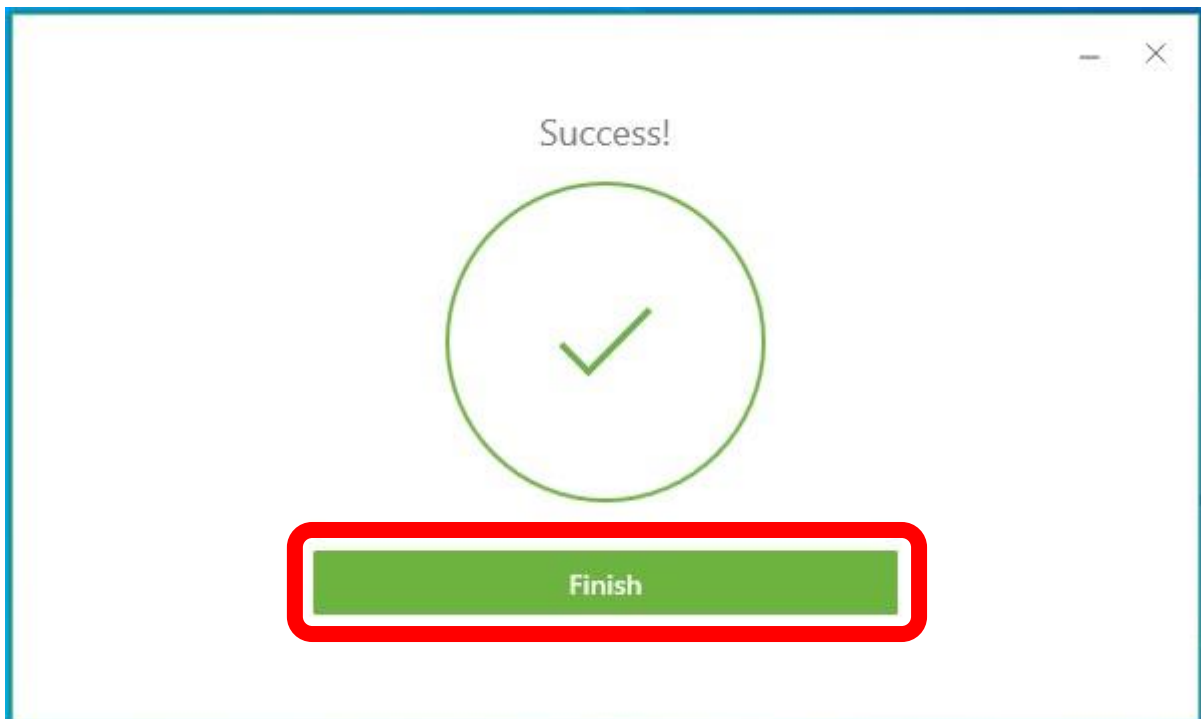
Step 3.1

The installation time will vary depending on your hardware's capabilities.



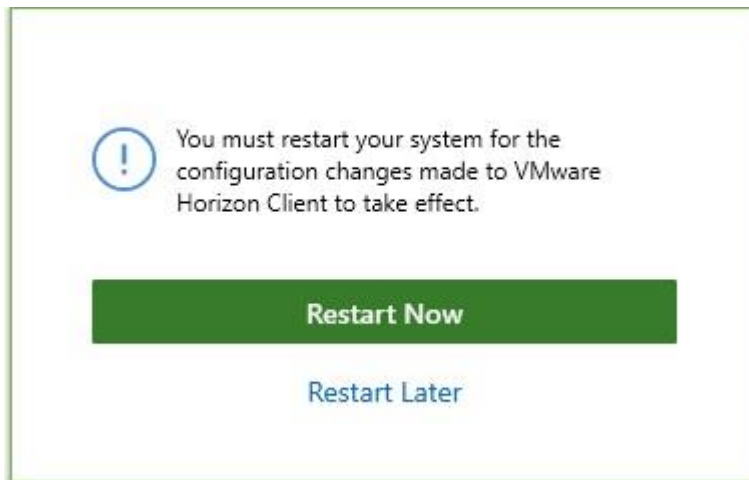
Step 3.2

Once the installation is complete you will be presented with the window below. Click 'Finish'.



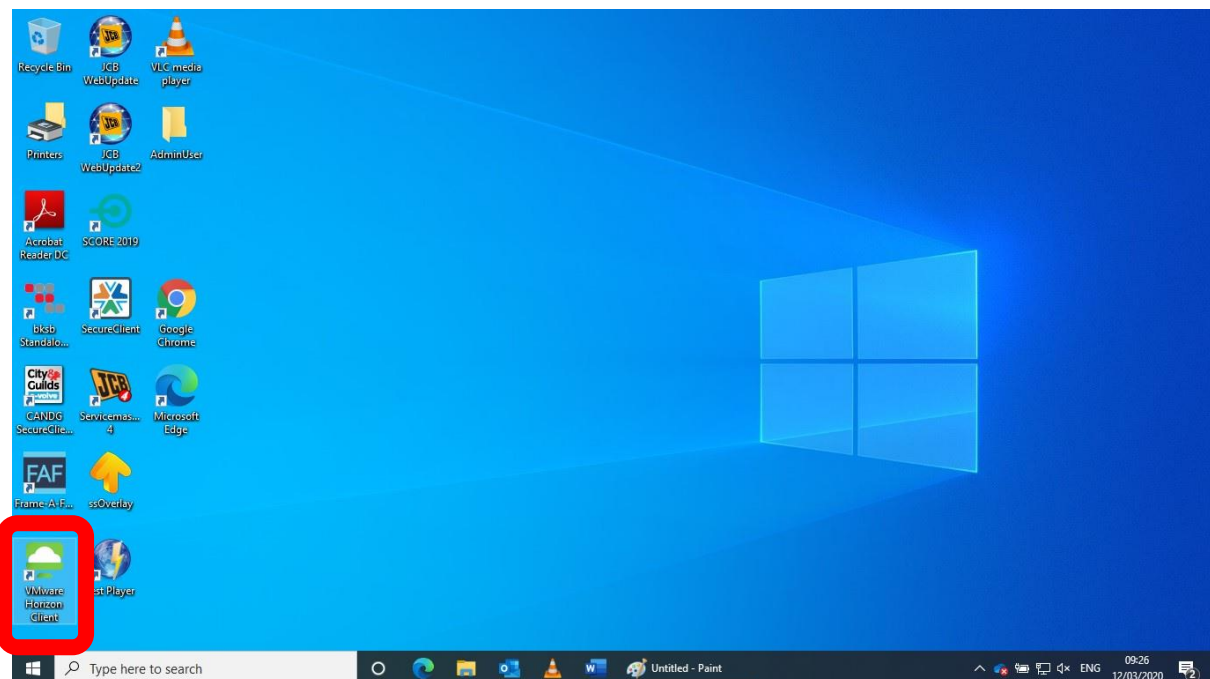

Then click 'Restart Now'. This will restart your computer so be sure to save any work you currently have open.

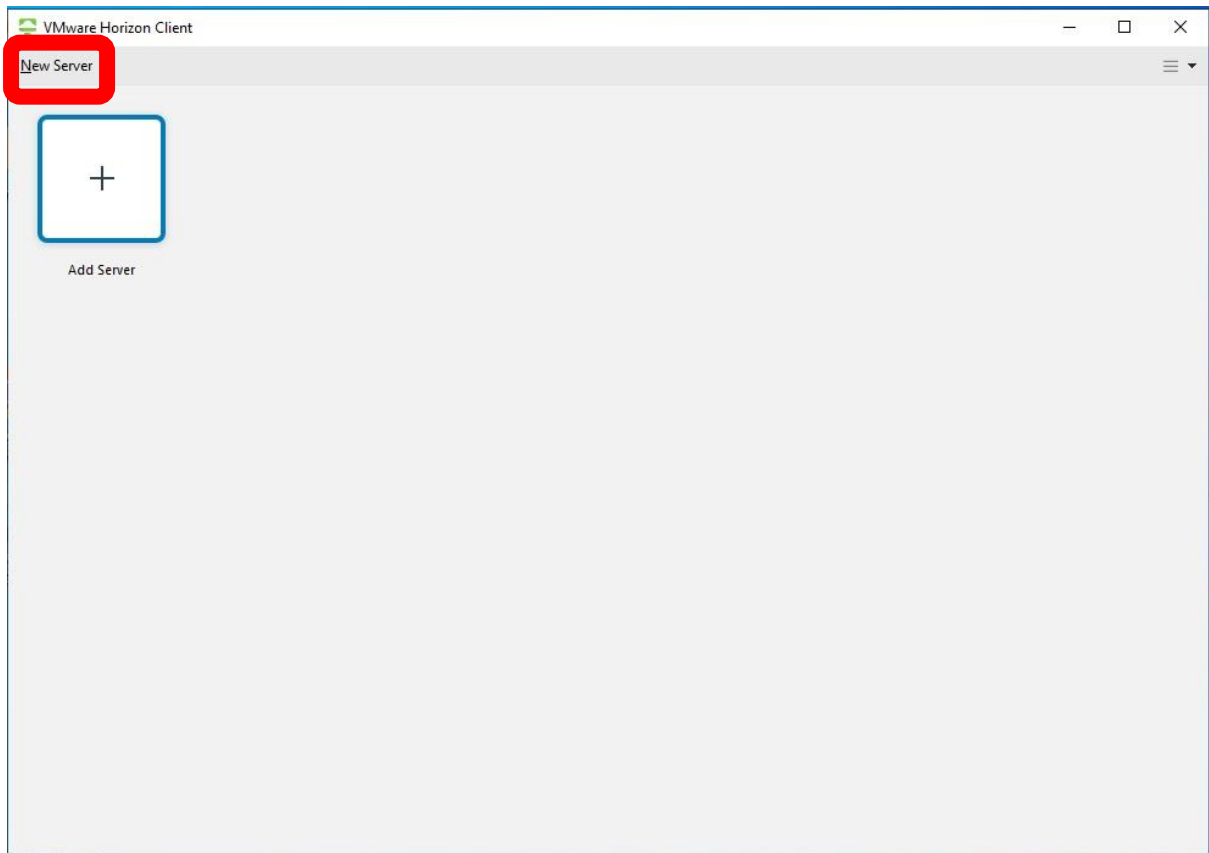


Step 4 – VMware Horizon Setup

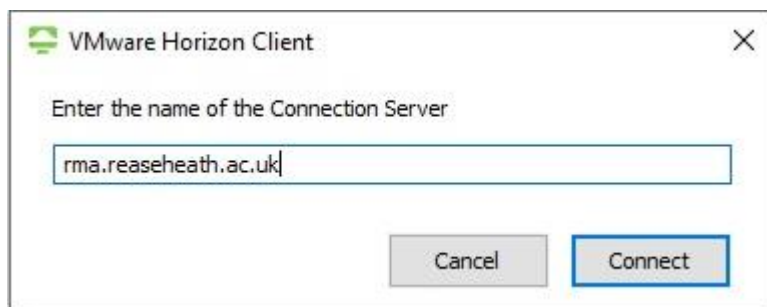
Once your computer has restarted and you have signed in open the VMware Horizon client.

Click 'New Server'

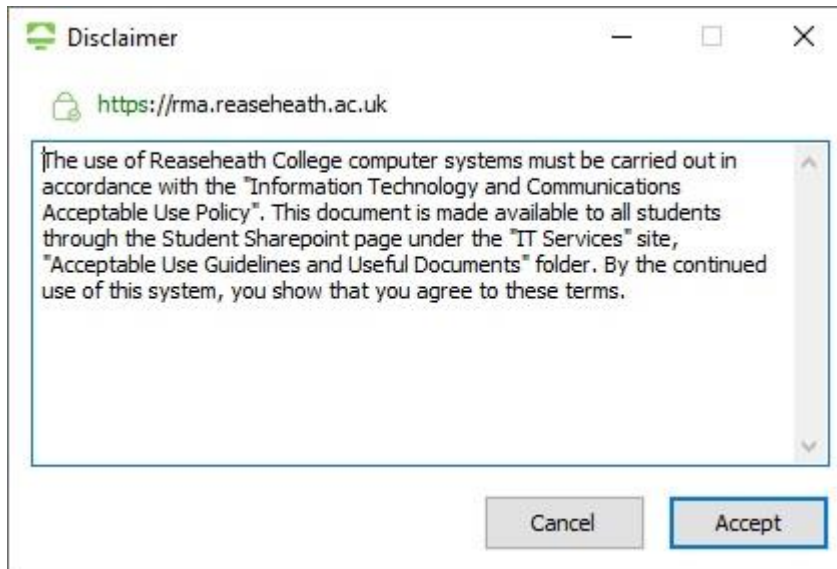


Step 4.2
Enter 'rma.reaseheath.ac.uk' in the dialogue box.



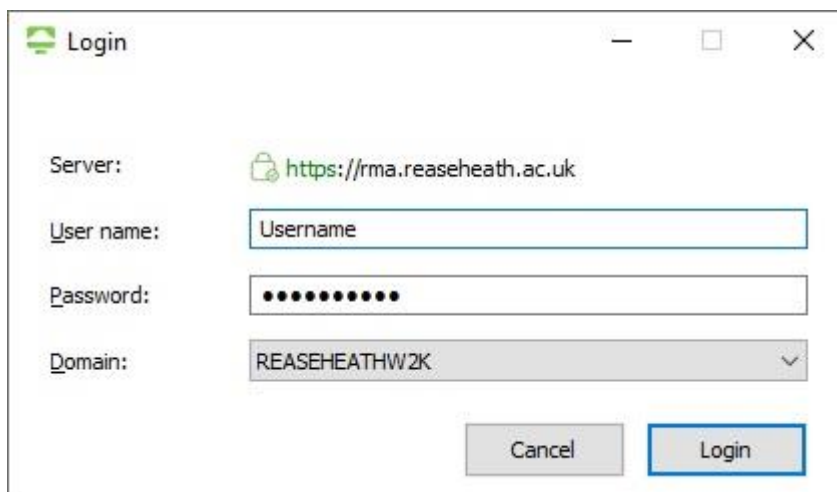

Read the disclaimer and click 'Accept' to agree to the terms stated.



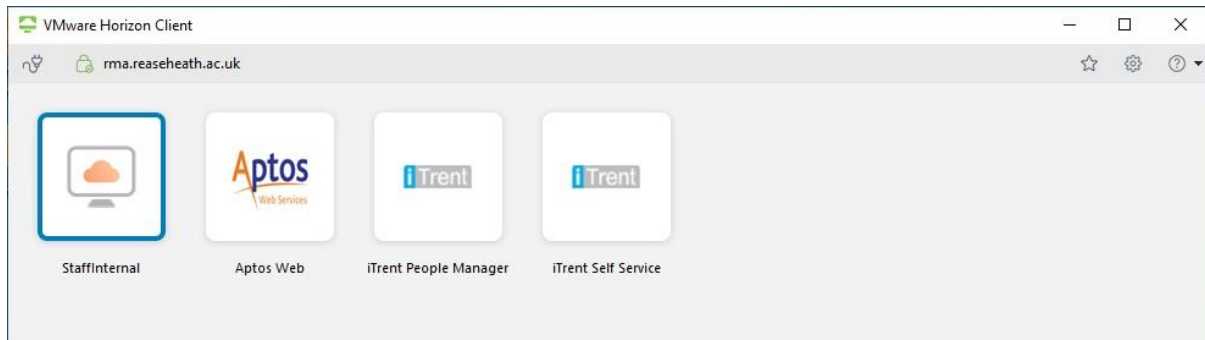

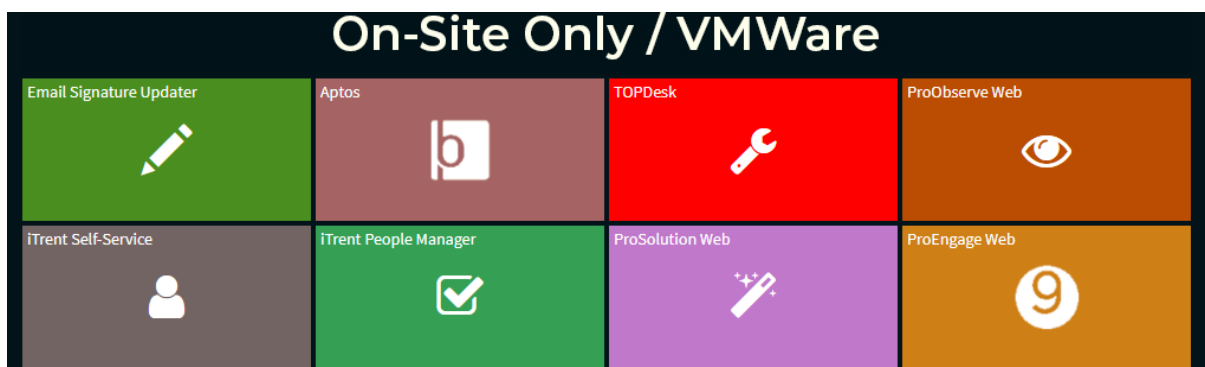


StaffInternal/StaffExternal



Note: When accessing VMware offsite, this option will show as 'StaffExternal'.

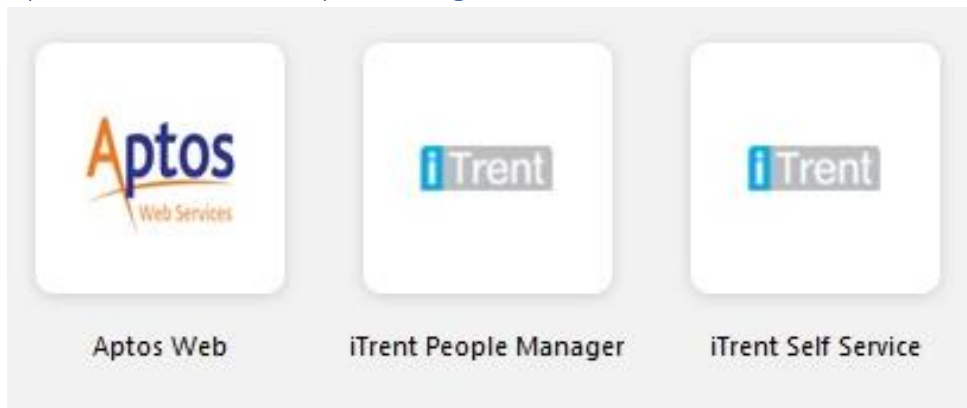

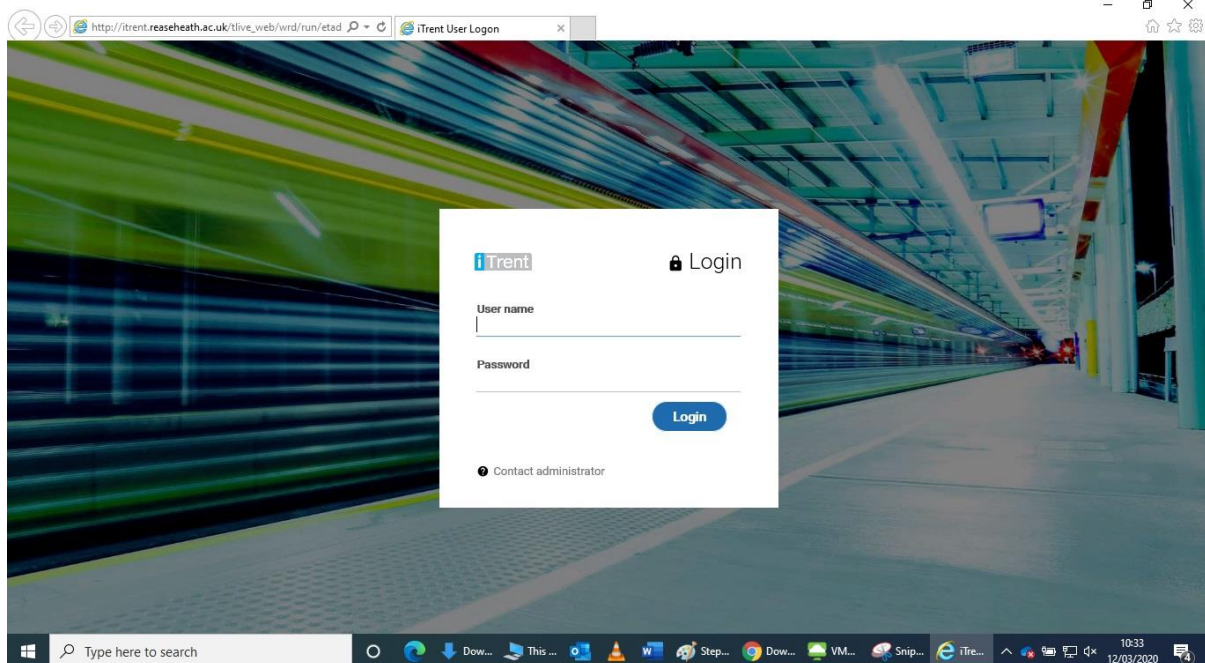
You can also access your internal network drives this way:
