

Henry Sale Foundation Bursary

The Henry Sale Foundation was set up in 2016. The Foundation aims to celebrate Henry's life and continue his legacy through the charitable causes they support. The Foundation's charitable principles were inspired by Henry's love of countryside values, the rural community and an active way of life and his deep understanding of how these can contribute to everybody's wellbeing.

The Foundation supports the following areas:

- **Social Inclusion** - Helping individuals integrate into society and bringing communities together are at the core of how we like to support our principles
- **Education** - Promoting education is key to making a lasting difference. Helping individuals and communities understand the countryside, and giving them the knowledge to live healthy, active lifestyles are highly viewed by the trustees. This is closely linked to the following...
- **Helping People and Charities to Help Themselves** - Any causes focused on helping people to help themselves, or charities just starting out with the intention to become self-funding in the future are positively considered by the Foundation. We think supporting causes or charities like these are the most effective ways to allocate our funds

The college has been chosen as a recipient of award funds to distribute to Students and to follow the principles of the Henry Sale Foundation in making awards particularly:

- Those which encourage better management of the countryside and its way of life, and the rural economy
- Those which promote social inclusion
- Those which provide an educational resource not otherwise available
- Those which enable greater participation in sport and healthy recreation
- Those which provide accessibility, mobility and recreation to disabled people, including those who are victims of a traumatic event

Selection Criteria set by the Henry Sale Foundation

- In the case of educational support being offered, the intention should be that the beneficiary gains an opportunity for further education which would not otherwise have been available
- The fund is open to FE who have looked at other forms of funding and for whom the opportunity to study would not be possible. Applications should be received by the Student Finance Team by 1st August 2020

The college will set general guidelines for the awarding of funds from the Foundation but may use discretion on a case by case basis provided they follow the general principles of the Foundation.

Applicants should provide a written statement of why they wish to receive funding including full financial information of the student and family if appropriate. Students who have already given the college full financial information for application for other sources of funding may not need to resubmit this information. Supplementary information should be provided from outside agencies or referees if this is felt that this would give further evidence to support the application.

If the student is already enrolled at college discussion will be held with the tutor in support of the Application.

All applications for an award will be reviewed by the Head of Finance or Vice Principle Finance and Resources. They will decide if the application requires a panel for discussion or whether the award can be made directly.

Awards will be made in writing and will highlight the conditions attached to the award which the student will need to agree to. A signature accepting these conditions must be received before any awards are granted. Conditions may vary depending on the needs of the student but could include:

- Attendance levels
- Engagement in lessons, completing formative homework and assessments as required.
- Attendance at all exams including mocks and internal exams
- Participation in full of the BeReady programme
- Involvement in Student Life activities particularly in sport or healthy activity
- A summary of what the year at college, achievements, plans for the future etc and an acknowledgement of the award for the Henry Sale Foundation
- Engagement with the Henry Sale Foundation if they require reports, media or participation in their events
- Participation in RAG to support the college fundraising to give back to others

The college makes the decision regarding awards and may only give partial awards if funds are limited and demand exceeds the funds. The Head of Finance and Vice Principle Finance and Resources have authority to make final decisions on the use of the Foundation funds.
