your teeth

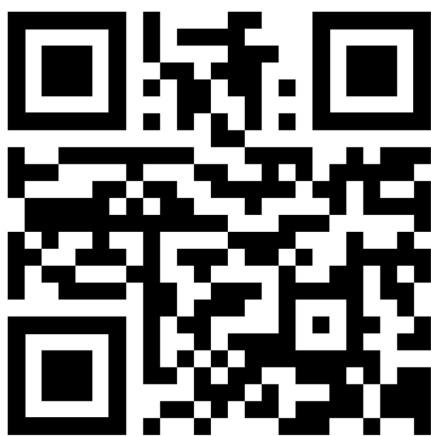
