Whether you are a regular competitor or a happy hacker, we have a day camps or weekend camps full of training available, each tailored to yours and your own horse's own goals with experts from across the equine sector.

For our weekend campers:

Friday will focus on establishing both yours and your horse's current level and goal setting. This will be built up across the weekend, with ridden and mechanical horse lessons on Saturday, along with a Pilates session to develop your core strength, balance and position. Sunday will hold a final day competition or lesson, review of yours and your horse's progress throughout the weekend.

Throughout the weekend, our expert coaches will tailor sessions to meet your needs and you will be in groups determined by the experience and confidence levels of both horse and rider. You can tell us about yourself and your horse on the questionnaire attached. So please provide as much information as possible.

For our day camps: Your day will focus on both yours and your horse's current level and finding positive ways to improve your riding as well as have some fun with like minded people. Designed to develop yours and your horse's confidence and enhance your partnership, there's no reason not to join us!

# Reaseheath Equestrian Facilities

# The Venue

Campers will have exclusive use of the Reaseheath Equestrian Centre. Comprising of an international sized Indoor Arena (30m x 60m) Surfaced with Martin colin's eco track and Outdoor Arena (60m x 30m) surfaced with Andrews Bowen Pro-Wax surface. Dressage letters, boards and flowers will used during ridden sessions.

The Equestrian Centre also possesses a Racewood Equestrian Simulator, complete with 180° mirrors which campers will use to develop position and technique with a Professional Coach, enhancing your partnership with your horse and improving performance.



# **Stabling**

Stabling is included in the price for the camp and is provided on the Reaseheath American Barn complex. Two bales of shavings for weekend camps and a small straw bed for day camps and ad lib forage (hay or haylage) is included.

Each stable is 12x12ft or 12x14ft with rubber matting provided at the front of the stables.

Storage is available at the front of stables and there is a secure tack room for tack, but possessions are stored here or in trailers/horseboxes at your own risk. You are welcome to bring bags to take home any leftover bedding from your stable! We do ask that you clear bedding upon departure; if this is not the case, a cleaning fee will be charged.

You will need to bring your own water buckets, haynets, mucking out equipment etc with you and no grazing in hand is available whilst at Camp. Owners will have access to 2 wash down areas with hot and cold hosing.

# **Vaccinations**

Please ensure all passports and vaccinations against equine influenza are up to date before attending our Camp. Horses are required to have had at the very least the first 2 vaccinations within the vets specified timescales.

In addition all horses must have received a booster vaccination within the 12 months prior to arriving at the stables, but must not have had any vaccination in the 6 days prior to arriving.

Horses with out of date vaccinations will not be permitted on to the site and you will be turned away without refund.

There is no onsite accommodation available for 2022 camps, however parking for horse boxes and trailers is available on our Equine car park, with access to toilet facilities in our indoor arena, as well as access to an additional onsite shower block.

Evening meal\* will be served in the College restaurant on main campus, with meat or vegetarian options, with a choice of cake or fruit for your dessert. Vegetarian options of these dishes will also be available. Please note any specific dietary requirements on your questionnaire.

Please note, we are a cashless campus, however, card can by used to purchase an additional items if required. Friday evening meal will be at the local pub, this is an addition and is not Included in the catering plan and the price of camp. Transport is available to and from this meal if required.

# **Directions:**

### From the North, South and East

- Use M6 to Junction 16, then A500/A51 towards Nantwich/Chester
- Follow the A500/A51, signposted Chester, for approximately 10 miles (you may notice that this is, in part, a new road)
- After approximately 8 miles you will by-pass Nantwich
- Do not turn towards Nantwich. Continue on the A500/A51 signposted Chester
- At roundabout take the second exit (A51 to Chester)
- The entrance to the Equestrian Centre is on the left-hand side of the road approx. 100 metres from the roundabout

## From North Wales and Chester

- Use A51 towards Nantwich
- Follow A51 turning left at traffic lights on outskirts of Nantwich (still A51 and signposted Crewe/Congleton/ Stoke/M6)
- Continue for approximately 1 mile and the entrance to the Equestrian Centre is on the right-hand side of the road approx. 100 metres from the roundabout

# From South Wales and Shrewsbury via Whitchurch

- Use A530 from Whitchurch for 8 miles to Nantwich
- Bear right on passing Nantwich Lake on left
- At T junction turn left, continue over level crossing and take first exit at roundabout
- Continue over pedestrian crossing then at next traffic lights turn right (passing through town centre)
- At traffic lights at crossroads turn left
- Pass straight through next set of traffic lights
- At roundabout take the first exit (A51 to Chester)
- The entrance to the Equestrian Centre is on the left-hand side of the road approx. 100 metres from the rounda-



# **Terms and Conditions**

### **Booking:**

The deposit is non refundable - no refunds of deposit are given for change of mind or circumstances

Total Refund - As long as cancelation is 1 month prior to event.

Before 1 month prior a full refund will be given on production of a Vet's/Dr's certificate stating that the horse/you will not be fit for work in July/Aug. In all other circumstances the balance, less the deposit, will be refunded <u>providing we can fill your space</u>, if we can not, any payments already made can not be refunded.

No refunds will be given. As with all holidays it is advisable to get your own insurance, should you need to cancel costs will be covered.

### **General:**

Please report to the organisers on arrival and follow the instructions of the organiser or coaches during your time at camp.

You will be required to provide vehicle make, model and registration on arrival for health & safety and identification.

All riders are responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.

All riders must have previous experience of riding the horse they have entered into the event.

Always ride, with courtesy, care and consideration to fellow participants and follow instructions of the coach at all times.

No-one other than the rider listed on the booking form may ride your horse whilst at camp.

No lead rein riders/ horses are allowed.

All entrants must hold third party public liability insurance either through being a Gold member of The British Horse Society or via proof from another provider.

Everyone attending the event is responsible for ensuring the safety of themselves and others.

Reaseheath College cannot provide supervision for attendees under the age of 18 for this event. It is a recommendation that any attendee below the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a responsible adult who remains at the venue for the duration of the course or event. For attendees aged 15-17, or an adult at risk, it is at the discretion of their parent or guardian. Accompanying adults may need to pay to attend the event, this is at the discretion of the event organiser this can be done at an additional cost of £35 this provides catering etc for the extra attendee.

Please leave the parking area as you found it – place droppings in the provided wheelbarrows.

Dogs are NOT permitted.

### **Riders:**

No hacking is permitted

All riders must wear suitable riding footwear. Wellington boots and trainers are not allowed.

Riders are advised to carry a mobile phone and be aware of the emergency contact number for the event.

Hats to the current standard must be worn and correctly secured at all times when mounted. Please check yours meets <u>current standards</u>.

Body protectors, if worn, should comply with current standards.

### **Your Horse:**

All horses must be over the age of five years and of appropriate fitness level for the activity being undertaken - any horses who are not sound or fit enough for the activity undertaken will be retired from the activity by decision of the coach.

No stallions are permitted.

No turnout will be available during the camp.

Tack must be in safe condition and fit correctly - this is your responsibility to ensure before attending camp.

Don't forget it is a legal requirement to have your horses' passport when travelling to events.

You are responsible for any damage created by your horse to any facilities whilst on site and will therefore be liable for the cost of replacing/repairing.

The aim of this camp is to promote the improvement of riding, training of ponies/ horses and horsemanship in a safe and enjoyable environment. Welfare of horses and everyone's health and safety is of paramount importance.

# **Terms and Conditions**

If any concerns are noted, please understand that this may prohibit an individual's opportunity to participate in some or all of the activities.

All horses must be up to date with annual equine influenza vaccinations and must be 6 days clear from their most recent booster vaccination. Further vaccination guidance can be found using the BRC Flu Vac Checker, downloadable <a href="here">here</a>. Spot checks will be made at the event.

Horses should not be left unattended when tied to horseboxes, in the parking area or on the ride.

### Covid-19

Reaseheath is a cashless campus, therefore cash is not accepted. Vending machines utilize card payments.

Anyone feeling unwell with Covid-19 type symptoms must not attend.

Anyone displaying Covid-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. Anyone who has been in contact with someone that is showing symptoms should stay at home. Anyone considered vulnerable should stay at home. Please inform the organizer if you need to withdraw.

Sanitizer will be provided at appropriate locations and all attending should make use of it.

Maintain social distancing from others.

There will be first aid cover. The first aider will have PPE in case they have to break social distancing guidelines.

Anyone not complying with current event Covid-19 Health and Safety protocol will be asked to leave the site. There are no exceptions to this rule.
