APPLY FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Financial support may be available to you

If you are studying on a full-time course with us, you may be eligible for meanstested financial support to help pay for your accommodation, transport, or essential clothing and equipment.

Bursary applications are now open. If you are eligible, have your student ID number to hand and apply as soon as possible. We aim to process all applications within two weeks and a letter detailing the outcome will be emailed to you.

Paying for items at college

Reaseheath College is a cashless campus. The easiest way to pay for food in our catering facilities is by using your student ID card.

You will be able to load money onto your student ID card through our iPay system. Once you have started at college and received your log in credentials you will be able to start using your iPay account. If your parent or carer would like access to your account to top-up on your behalf this can be requested via iPay once you are logged in to the system.



2 APPLY FOR YOUR ACCOMMODATION OR TRANSPORT

If you want to live in our on-site accommodation or use our college transport while you're a student with us, you need to apply for these now if you haven't already.

How to apply for accommodation

Living in our purpose-built, on-site residential student accommodation is a popular option with our students. As a residential student at Reaseheath, you will be within walking distance to your classes and our great social facilities too, and you will also be fully supported by our fantastic safeguarding team who are available 24/7.

How to apply for transport

If you would rather travel to Reaseheath each day, we offer over 20 different bus routes across Cheshire and surrounding areas. All our buses are high quality, fitted with seat belts and driven by DBS checked drivers for your safety.

If you would rather travel by train, we are also able to collect students from several train stations, including two pick-ups from Crewe Railway Station. Places are limited, so we advise you to apply as soon as possible. If you delay your application, we will be unable to quarantee processing your bus pass in time for the start of term. You will receive a temporary bus pass by email for your first few days, and be issued with your permanent pass during induction. 3 COMPLETE YOUR ENROLMENT

GET YOURSELF KITTED OUT

There are not many more steps now until you are ready to start at Reaseheath College!

Before you arrive, you will need to complete your enrolment online, Your enrolment link has been sent to you via email. Sort your photo ID

As part of the online enrolment process you will be asked to submit your photo. This is so that we can prepare your student ID card ready for your first day.

If you're unable to provide your photo at the time of enrolling that won't be a problem. Please send it as soon as possible by email to **photos@reaseheath.ac.uk** and include your full name and student ID number

Your photo must be high quality, clearly showing your face, and taken in good lighting.

Depending on the course you have chosen to study, there may be some equipment and clothing you need to buy before you start in September.

Visit the Applicant Hub to find out what kit you need for your course: reaseheath.ac.uk/kit-list. Much of the kit you need, including uniform, is available to purchase from our online shop.

Please be aware that orders can take an average of one week to be delivered or longer during busy periods, so order as early as you can to avoid delay.



5 SUBMIT YOUR GCSE RESULTS

Your GCSE results will be released on 25 August 2022. On results day head over to our applicant hub to upload your GCSE results: reaseheath.ac.uk/gcse-results
