Schedule & Rules

In hand qualification classes will be held in the 20x40m outdoor arena, and the ridden qualification classes will be held in the indoor arena.

Both championship classes will be held in the indoor arena.

Both arenas will start at 9AM

In Hand Classes- Outdoor Arena- 9am

Class 1 – In-hand Open Youngstock

1-, 2- or 3-year-old. No foals

Class 2 – Novice Horse & Pony

6 years and under. No foals

Class 3 – Young Handler

Handlers must be 16 years and under. Adult assistance is allowed.

Class 4 – Open In-hand

Any height, age, or type

Class 5 –In-hand Hunter/Cob/Heavy Horse Type

Class 6 – In-hand Mountain and Moorland

Small and large breed, including Welsh.

Class 7 – In-hand Coloured and Traditional Gypsy Cob

May be hogged or hairy.

Class 8– In-hand Shetland/Miniature Pony

Class 9- Alternative Colour

Class 10 – In-hand Veterans

15 years and over

Class 11 – In-hand Riding Horse/Hack/RoR

Class 12 – In-Hand Championship

Classes 1 – 11 (all 1st and 2nd placings)

Ridden Classes- Indoor Arena- 9am

Class 13 – Ridden Veterans

Horses and ponies aged 15 years and over. Riders any age.

Class 14 – Alternative Colour

Spotted/Palomino/Duns/Cremello's

Class 15 – Foreign Breeds

Class 16 – Coloureds and Traditional Gypsy Cobs

May be hogged or hairy.

Class 17- Riding Horse/Hack/RoR

Class 18 – Lead Rein/First Ridden

Must be lead from the noseband. Optional canter. Class may be split into lead rein and first ridden if enough entries.

Class 19 – Novice Rider

Not to have won a 1st. Genuine novices only please. Snaffle bridle only. No extension required.

Class 20 – Novice Horse & Pony

Horse and pony over 4 years old, riders any age. Must be suitable size for the equine ridden. **Please only genuine novices.**

Snaffle bridle only, cavesson noseband. No extension required.

Class 21 – Open Ridden

Any height or type, horses and ponies to be over the age of 4 years old. Riders any age but excludes lead reins and first ridden.

Class 22 – Hunter/Cob/Heavy Horse Type

Class 23 – Open Mountain and Moorland

Small and large breed including Welsh.

Class 24 – Ridden Championship

Classes 13 – 23 (all 1st and 2nd placings)
