Supported internships

If you would like to gain the skills needed to progress into paid employment, you can complete a supported internship as part of your course at Reaseheath College!

What is a supported internship?

Supported internships are endorsed by the Department of Education and have been specifically designed to help learners aged 16 – 24 who have an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP) gain paid employment in the workplace, with additional support along the way.

How does a supported internship work?

As a supported intern, you will spend one day a week at Reaseheath College developing your Maths, English and Employability skills as part of a bespoke programme to suit your needs.

You will also participate in our BeReady programme to gain further skills, knowledge and behaviour to excel in the workplace. Additionally, you would then work in your placement for two days a week, however this can be flexible to meet business and learner needs

What support will I receive during my internship?

In your internship, you will be supported by a specialist job coach provided by the college. The job coach will support you until you are confident to work more independently in your workplace with the guidance and support of your colleagues. This usually starts at 100% support, and fades gradually week by week.

Who can apply for a supported internship?

To apply for a supported internship, you must have:

- A current EducationHealth Care Plan (EHCP)
- A desire to work

Please note, supported internships are a part of our internal offer allowing progressing students to access employment. Typically, places are limited and subject to vocational profile and successful employer match. Priority is given to internally progressing students however we do liaise with local authorities where other suitable candidates may be identified.

If you wish to enrol onto the programme, you will meet with our Supported Internship Coordinator to discuss what your career goals are and what vocational area you wish to pursue. From here we will match you to a suitable employer.
