



Sports facilities at Reaseheath College

We've raised the bar with our £6 million Sports Science and Performance Academy, so at Reaseheath College you'll have access to some of the very best facilities and resources in the country.

Sports pitches

Our state-of-the-art sports hub contains a 3G international rugby standard floodlit pitch and an all-weather multi-use games area (MUGA). There is also a four-court sports hall with separate changing and shower rooms along with accessible facilities.

Sports Performance Centre

In our dedicated sports performance centre, students and professional athletes alike are assisted to achieve their training goals by using our altitude chamber, bioelectrical impedance equipment (used to analyse body fat percentage), Cos-Med respiratory analysis, medical grade treadmill, Wattbike and Lode cycling ergometer.

On-site training gym

Our fantastic training gym on-site is equipped with TechnoGym equipment and an Olympic weightlifting platform. We also have cardiovascular machines, treadmills, cross trainers, upright bikes, studio bikes and much more.

Fitness studio

Our new fitness studio, part of a £6 million investment into our sports facilities, has a floor to ceiling mirrored wall and a new studio with first-class equipment including Olympic standard weightlifting platform, a range of kettlebells from 8kg-25kg, modifiable barbells for muscular endurance training and class-based exercises, plyometric boxes and 10 rear wheel spin bikes.

Adventure Sports facilities

If your sights are set on studying Adventure Sports, you will also benefit from a range of first-class resources on campus including our college lake which is great for developing your kayaking skills, our 30ft high ropes course and our indoor climbing wall.
