Reaseheath College is focused on encouraging students to BeMore and dedicated to delivering a strong careers programme which meets the needs of all students. Our Careers programme is intended to raise aspirations and ensure students are Industry Focused, Career Ready with clear knowledge and understanding of the local and national labour markets to enable then to pursue their chosen career path. #### 1. A stable careers programme

Students are well supported to become career ready throughout their time at Reaseheath College. Thanks to our stable careers programme, students can access information, advice and guidance and career related activities which includes industry focused qualification, highly experienced tutors, strong industry partners, work placements and regular opportunities to develop key employability skills through our BeMore programme and extra-curricular activities.

## 2. Learning from career and labour market information

We are dedicated to ensuring our courses give students the skills required to meet local and national needs. Many of our courses, including our new T Level qualifications, have been designed in collaboration with employers, and we regularly use the latest career and labour market information to inform our careers programme so that students gain the skills and knowledge required to excel in the industry.

#### 3. Addressing the needs of each student

We understand that our students have different interests and career aspirations, which is why our students have regular 1:1 contact with their Progress Coach and are supported when considering their next steps through 1:1 and group activities. Career advisors are accessible throughout the year for personalised advice and guidance at any time.

#### 4. Linking curriculum learning to careers

Our curriculum is highly focused on giving our students the career related skills they need for work in the industry and allows them to link their learning to career progression.
