

## Showing Schedule Winter Series 25/26

### In Hand Classes – Indoor Arena – 9:30am start

**Class 1 – Best turned out** – Open to all types and heights

**Class 2 – Open Youngstock** – Including foals – 3-year-olds

**Class 3 – Novice Horse & Pony** – Not to have won an open showing class before 1st Jan in current year. No foals

**Class 4 – Young Handler** – Handlers must be 16 years and under. Adult assistance is allowed.

**Class 5 – Open Pony** – Any type 14.2hh and under

**Class 6 – M&M** – small and large breed, including Welsh A, B,C and D's

**Class 7 – Coloured's (Traditional/Natives)** – May be shown hogged or traditional.

**Class 8 – Coloured's Non-Native** – Plaited

**Class 9 – Alternative Coloured Native and Non-Native** - Coloured, Spotted, Palomino, Dun or Roan - open to horses & ponies any height and breed.

**Class 10 – Foreign and Rare Breeds** – Open to Appaloosa, Haflinger, Fjords, Lusitano, Morgan, American Quarter horse, Standardbred, Friesian, Lipizzaner, Caspian, Knabstrupper, KWPN.

**Class 11 - Riding Horse/Hack/RoR**

**Class 12 – Open Horse** – Any type exceeding 14.2hh

**Class 13 – Hunter/Heavy Horse Type**

**Class 14 – Veterans** – Horse/pony over 15 years, class maybe split if sufficient entries

**Class 15 – In Hand Championship** -1<sup>st</sup>- 2<sup>nd</sup> place from classes 2-14

## **Ridden Classes – Indoor Arena – Not to start before 1:30pm**

**Class 16 – Best turned out** – Open to all types and Heights

**Class 17 - Lead Rein** – Must be lead from the noseband.

**Class 17b- First ridden** - Optional canter. \*

**Class 18 – Novice Rider** – Rider not to have won an open showing class. Snaffle bridles only, canter is not mandatory. \*

**Class 19 – Novice Horse/Pony** - Not to have won an open showing class before the 1<sup>st</sup> of Jan in current year. Snaffle bridles only. \*

**Class 20 – Show Hunter Pony** – Mixed Height

**Class 21 – Show Pony** – Mixed Height

**Class 22 – Open Pony** – Any type not exceeding 14.2hh

**Class 23 – M&M** – small and large breed, including Welsh A, B,C and D's

**Class 24 – Coloured's and Traditional/ Natives** – May be shown hogged or traditional

**Class 24b - Coloured's Non-Native** – Plaited

**Class 25 – Alternative Coloured Native and Non-Native** - Coloured, Spotted, Palomino, Dun or Roan - open to horses & ponies any height and breed.

**Class 26 –Foreign and Rare Breeds** – Open to Appaloosa, Haflinger, Fjords, Lusitano, Morgan, American Quarter horse, Standardbred, Friesian, Lipizzaner, Caspian, Knabstrupper, KWPN.

**Class 27 –Riding Horse/Hack/ROR**

**Class 28 –Open Horse** – Any type exceeding 14.2hh

**Class 29 - Equitation**

**Class 30 –Riding Club Horse/Pony** – An individual show including a small cross pole.

**Class 31 – Show Cob**

**Class 32 –Hunter**

**Class 33 – Veterans** - Horse/pony over 15 years, class maybe split if sufficient entries

**Class 34** – Ridden Champion - 1<sup>st</sup>- 2<sup>nd</sup> place from classes 17 – 29
