RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY

- **Dressage Classes 1, 2, 3 & 8-11**
Open to Horses and Ponies 4 years of age and over.
- **Senior Pony/Horse Classes (4-7)**
Open to Horses and Ponies aged 15 years and over.

2. PASSPORTS

- All ponies/horses must have their passports with them.
- Random checks may be carried out.

3. RIGHT OF REFUSAL

- Show organizers reserve the right to **refuse** entry to any person without **explanation**.
- The Committee reserves the right to amend schedules or timings if necessary.

4. CONDUCT

- Anyone found behaving inappropriately or using inappropriate language towards any judge or show official will be **dis-qualified**.
- The judge's decision is final and **binding**.

7. SPURS

- Spurs are permitted in Dressage Classes for competitors aged **16 years and over** (unless restricted for health reasons).

8. REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will **NOT** be refunded under any circumstances.

9. GALLERS

- Callers are **allowed** in dressage tests.

10. DOGS

- All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Please clean up after them.

DIRECTIONS TO ONLEY GROUNDS EQUESTRIAN COMPLEX

FROM M1 (COMING FROM THE NORTH)

- Leave the M1 at Junction 18.
- At the roundabout, turn towards DIRFT.
- At the next roundabout, turn left.
- At the following roundabout, go straight over (Eddie Stobart will be on your left).
- At the next roundabout, turn left onto the A5.
- Follow this road into Klisby (please adhere to the 30mph speed limit – speed cameras in operation).
- At the roundabout, follow the A30 to the right through Klisby.
- Once out of the village, go over the M45 bridge and take the 1st for RIGHT signposted to BARBY.
- Continue to the crossroads, go straight over towards the A45 (Watch out for the bridge over the canal. Narrow).
- At the A45 turn RIGHT, (Getting on here, you will pass the right for Chieve Prison on your right).
- Look for a green sign on the right which says FARM ACCESS – take that turn left by the barn conversions.
- Follow the driveway about ¼ mile up to the farm, at the top left into the yard. Welcome to Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex!

FROM M1 (COMING FROM THE SOUTH)

- Leave the M1 at Junction 17 and follow the M5: The exit junction can only be accessed southbound.
- Leave the M45 at first exit, signposted A45,
- Turn right at the exit roundabout onto the A45,
- Immediately after the Grandborough turning on the right, turn left by the barn conversions,
- Follow the driveway about ¼ mile up to the farm at the top left into the yard. Welcome to Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex!

FROM M40

- Leave the M40 at junction 11 onto the A34 (North Oxford).
- Level at Maffington, go north first exit off the A34/M40 roundabout.
- Follow the M40 onto junction 9 (Banbury), turn right by the 1st turn conversions.
- Continue through Banbury onto Southam, taking right onto the A420 (Rugby/Dunchurch).
- In Dunchurch, at the traffic lights, turn right onto the A45,
- Immediately after the Grandborough turning on the right turn left by the barn conversions,
- Follow the driveway about ¼ mile up to the farm at the top left into the yard. Welcome to Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex!

FROM M5

- Leave the M5 at Junction 9 onto the A46 eastbound (Ashchurch/Evesham/Stratford).
- Continue on the A46 (numerous fixed and mobile speed cameras).
- On the Renilworth Bypass, take exit onto the A45 towards Coventry Airport, Ryton, Rugby (Watch out for your speed, numerous fixed and mobile speed cameras).
- Join the M45 (DO NOT go) through Dunchurch/Key).
- Take the first exit of the M45 onto the A45, and at the ban roundabout turn right onto the A45,
- Immediately after the Grandborough turning on the right turn left by the barn conversions,
- Follow the driveway about ¼ mile up to the farm at the top left into the yard. Welcome to Onley Grounds Equestrian Complex!
